


American Artist*

Jean-Michel Basquiat was a groundbreaking artist from New York City who started as a street artist and became one of the most important painters of the 20th century.

He mixed words, symbols, and figures in his work to talk about identity, power, and history. Basquiat often painted in a bold, messy style that looked spontaneous but carried deep meaning. He celebrated Black culture and challenged unfair systems through his art.

His crown symbol became famous, showing how he saw himself and others as kings and queens.


